The Northern Middlesex Metropolitan Planning Organization (NMMPO) has released the Draft FFY 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for a 30 day public review and comment period. The TIP is a programming and management document containing all federally funded transportation projects planned over the next 5 years. The NMMPO has also released the Draft FFY 2017 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for a 30 day public review and comment period. The UPWP describes all transportation planning activities for the upcoming federal fiscal year. The NMMPO also released a proposed amendment to the current FFY 2016-2019 TIP, needed to ensure that all projects are fully funded. Please note, the TIP contains the program of projects for the Lowell Regional Transit Authority (LRTA). The MPO's public participation process satisfies the LRTA's public participation requirements for the program of projects.
