TO: Residents of Carter Street, Cart Path Road and Surrounding Area

RE: Water Main Replacement

DATE: July 7, 2017

Starting on Tuesday of next week (July 11th), the Town of Tewksbury under contract with Cedrone Corp. (Contractor) will be preparing to replace the existing water main on Carter Street and Cart Path Road beginning at the end of Cart Path Road and working out toward the intersection with East Street. At this time, the project is estimated to take approximately two months to complete.

Please note that the work will be performed during the daytime hours of 7:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m., and to the extent possible, traffic flow will be maintained. However, as you are all aware, there is limited access to Carter Street and Cart Path Road beyond Leston Street. Residents are asked to drive extremely slow when entering/exiting Carter Street and Cart Path Road. In addition, residents are asked to plan ahead in order to limit the number of trips in and out of the area to allow construction to progress as quickly as possible.

Over the course of the next several days, the Contractor will be installing temporary bypass water piping and service connections (blue/black plastic pipe and hoses) to all the homes serviced by the existing water main. Once installed, you will receive another notice indicating that the Town of Tewksbury's Water Department will need to shut off your existing service at the water meter in order to transfer your water service to the temporary bypass. This normally requires an employee from the Town's Water Department to enter the basement of your home. Please allow them access to the water meter and shut off.
