272 Whipple Road, the Melvin Rogers House is a well-preserved large Craftsman house constructed in Tewksbury during the early 20th century. It retains many character defining features: stucco side walls, overhanging eaves, decorative brackets, full width entrance porch, paired square columns, windows with multi-pane sashes over a single lower sash; as well as several locally unique features including the projecting full height entry bay on the west side of the house and the connected gable front dormers with a half round windows, wide verge boards, large supporting brackets, and a decorative finial. The property is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria C at the local level.
