RE: Town Meeting Warrant Article 13

Nancy Reed explained that the cost of renovating the Town Hall had gone up since the Article had been written and it needed to be changed to reflect this.

The Article requests the sum of \$825,000 be voted on at Town Meeting. An additional amount of \$587,000 is needed. The Article should be amended to now read \$1,412,000. The CPC is asking for the support of the Commission.

Warren Carey was interested in the total cost refurbished and asked if there was a bid or spec sheet to look at. Nancy Reed stated there is.

After discussion, Warren Carey made the motion, seconded by Thomas Churchill that the Historical Commission supports the CPC on Article 13 at the Annual Town Meeting, Monday, May 5, 2014. The Chair voted aye and the motion passed unanimously.
