Secretary's report Tuesday, January 20, 2015: Motion by Warren Carey, seconded
by Robert Hunter to accept the report passed unanimously.

Ella Fleming update: The situation at the school is being handled by the Town
Manager and the School Department. The Town Hall architect has been hired to
check out the building to see what can be done.

The Wamesit Indian statue has been sandblasted and resurfaced. Landscaping
plans have been held up by the work being done on Route 38. Thomas Churchill will
check with Director of Community Development Steven Sadwick for more information.

Thomas Churchill is checking on the status of the Pike House which eventually needs
to be moved. He gave an update on the Town Hall renovations. Work is expected to
be completed on schedule (August/September 2015). Information on the Town Hall
project can be obtained on the Town Web site.

The historical value of Rail Trails was discussed.

Warren Carey made the motion, seconded by Robert Hunter that the Chairman contact
the Town Manager and ask that the Town Shield be restored as part of the Town Hall
complete restoration. The Chair voted aye and the motion passed unanimously.
