The Town of Tewksbury, Massachusetts invites sealed proposals from Contractors for the Roof Replacement at Tewksbury Police Station, Tewksbury, Massachusetts. The work includes but is not limited to replacement of standing seam metal roofing with Architectural grade asphalt shingles and associated work. The estimated cost of the work is \$250,000.

Plans, specifications and other Contract Documents will be available 100% electronically and may be seen, examined or obtained at www.Projectdog.com for free using Project Code 815945, after 10:30AM Wednesday, October 19, 2016. Go to www.Projectdog.com and click "Sign Up" for free, or login with your existing account. Enter Project Code 815945 in the project locator box. All bids shall be submitted no later than 2:00PM on Wednesday, November 2, 2016 to the Office of the Town Manager, Tewksbury Town Hall, 1009 Main Street, Tewksbury, MA 01876. Bids will not be accepted after this date and time.

A pre-bid conference will be held for all interested parties on-site on Wednesday, October 26, 2016, 9:00 AM. Meet at the Tewksbury Police Station, 918 Main Street, Tewksbury, MA. Attendance at this pre-bid conference is strongly recommended for parties submitting a bid.

Each general bid shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a bid bond, or cash, or a certified check on, or a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company, payable to the Town of Tewksbury in the amount of five percent (5%) of value of the bid. Bid deposits will be dealt with as provided in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 44B.

To be given consideration, all general bids must be accompanied by a copy of the Bidder's Certificate of Eligibility and an Update Statement. The General Bidder must be certified eligible in the DCAMM Prime/General **Roofing** category.

Bids shall be made on the basis of the Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Industries, Pursuant to the Provisions of Chapter 149, Sections 26 to 27D inclusive of Massachusetts General Laws, a copy of which is attached to and is made a part of the Contract. Bidders' selection procedures and contract award shall be in conformity with applicable statutes of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Performance and Labor and Materials payment bonds in the full amount of the contract price will be required from the successful bidder.

The Awarding Authority reserves the right to reject any or all general bids, if it be in the public interest to do so.
