**CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SALT STORAGE SHED
TEWKSBURY, MASSACHUSETTS**

The Town of Tewksbury, Massachusetts invites sealed proposals from Contractors for the Construction of New Salt Storage Facility, Tewksbury, Massachusetts. The work includes but is not limited to construction of a new wood framed salt storage facility including site preparation, installation of electric fixtures, and asphalt paving. The estimated cost of the work is \$550,000.00.

Plans, specifications and other Contract Documents may be seen, examined or obtained via Project Dog at www.Projectdog.com. Go to wwwl.Projectdog.com, enter Project Code 807690 in the project locator box, and follow the prompts to a free downloadable Bid Set after 10:00 A.M., E.D.T., Wednesday, September 2, 2015. Bidders may also obtain a CD Bid Set from Projectdog, free for pick up. Purchase paper documents at www.Projectdog.com with a refundable deposit of \$50.00, which is refundable on return of said documents in good condition not later than thirty (30) days after the opening of bids. Documents will not be mailed.

Sealed file sub-bids for this project will be accepted from eligible bidders in the category of Roofing and Flashing at the Office of the Town Manager, Tewksbury Town Hall, Pike House, 464 Main Street, Tewksbury, MA 01876 until 12:00 PM, Thursday, September 17, 2015 at which place and time they shall be publicly opened, read aloud and recorded for presentation to the Awarding Authority. All Filed Sub-Bids shall be accompanied by a Certificate of Eligibility and a DCAMM Update Statement.

Sealed general bids for this project will be accepted from eligible bidders at the Office of the Town Manager, Tewksbury Town Hall, Pike House, 464 Main Street, Tewksbury, MA 01876 until 1:00 PM, Wednesday, September 23, 2015 at which place and time they shall be publicly opened, read aloud and recorded for presentation to the Awarding Authority.

A pre-bid conference will be held for all interested parties on-site on Wednesday, September 9, 2015 at 10:00 AM at 999 Whipple Road, Tewksbury, MA. Attendance at this pre-bid conference is strongly recommended for parties submitting a bid.

Each general bid, and each filed sub-bid shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a bid bond, or cash, or a certified check on, or a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company, payable to the Town of Tewksbury in the amount of five percent (5%) of the highest possible value of the bid, including any Add Alternates. Bid deposits will be dealt with as provided in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 44B.

To be given consideration, all general bids must be accompanied by a copy of the Bidder's Certificate of Eligibility and an Update Statement. The General Bidder must be certified eligible

in the DCAMM General Building Construction category.

Bids shall be made on the basis of the Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Industries, Pursuant to the Provisions of Chapter 149, Sections 26 to 27D inclusive of Massachusetts General Laws, a copy of which is attached to and is made a part of the Contract.

Bidders' selection procedures and contract award shall be in conformity with applicable statutes of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Performance and Labor and Materials payment bonds in the full amount of the contract price will be required from the successful bidder.

The Awarding Authority reserves the right to reject any or all general bids, if it be in the public interest to do so, and to reject any sub-bid on any sub-trade if it determines that such sub-bid does not represent the sub-bid of a person competent to perform the work as specified or that less than three such sub-bids were received and that the prices are not reasonable for acceptance without further competition.
