Page 5 Benefits: Demographics; the Town's Bond Rating is AA+. Workforce and Industry; Thermo Fisher Scientific Inc. purchased 2 Radcliff Road Building for 500 computer and scientific research and development jobs. Lowell Five Cent Savings Bank has located its Headquarter to 55,000-square-foot building at 30 International Place. T

Page 8 Infrastructure Improvements: Tewksbury High School construction is Complete. Tewksbury Town Hall renovations are complete. The Town's Water Treatment Facility was upgraded and expanded. The town is the in process of designing and constructing a new Center Fire Headquarters and a new 720 student Elementary School to replace two current Elementary Schools.

Page 9 Real Estate: Residence at Joan's Farm is a 96 unit apartment complex built in 2017. Balsam Place 192 unit apartment complex built in 2017.

Page 11 Sports: The Wamesit Lanes Family Entertainment Center opened in 2015 featuring luxury candlepin and tenpin bowling, indoor golf, arcade and restaurant and lounge.

Page 12 Healthcare: Lowell General Hospital is constructing a 13,000 SF urgent care and office building on Main Street to be open in 2019.

Page 13 Arts and Culture: The Lowell Memorial Auditorium is an indoor facility located in downtown Lowell, Massachusetts on Merrimack Street www.lowellauditorium.com. The venue hosts concerts, family shows, conferences, conventions, trade shows, corporate seminars and much more. The 2,800 seat venue was constructed in 1922 by the architectural firm of Blackall, Clapp & Whittemore. The Lowell Memorial Auditorium is located in beautiful and historic downtown Lowell and is managed by Lowell Management Group.
