## **UPDATED** **FISKE STREET & BAILEY ROAD** **ROADWAY CLOSURE / DETOUR NOTICE**

### **Dear Residents:**


Starting on Thursday, May 1, 2025 a roadway closure and detour will be implemented on Fiske Street and Bailey Road as part of the Town's Roadway Resurfacing Project. Fiske Street and Bailey Road are to be closed between Andover Street and River Road and will be detoured during construction hours only (typically 7:00AM to 3:30PM) Monday to Friday. Traffic will be detoured in both directions utilizing Trull Road as a detour route.

Residents that live within the closed portion of the streets listed above, will have restricted access to the roads and their driveways during the work day. Residents should plan accordingly to leave prior to 7:00AM and where practical to return after 3:30PM. This will include residents on Bridle Path, Chivas Circle, Joseph Drive, Maplewood Road, Sawyers Lane, Scotland Drive, Woodcrest Drive.

Depending on where the active construction zone is located each day, residents may need to access their houses from either the Andover Street or River Road as directed. It is also possible that there will be significant delays leaving or returning to the house. Traffic Control Officers will be on-site to direct traffic and detour signs will be posted along the detour route and side streets within the roadway closure area. This roadway closure and detour is anticipated to last for approximately four weeks.

School Buses will not be impacted by these detours and will be allowed to bypass the detour routes in order to pickup and drop-off students at their normal times and locations. Emergency vehicles will have full access as needed to the work zone. Trash collection and mail delivery vehicles will also be allowed to bypass the roadway closure to access residences.

A plan showing the detour route is shown on the reverse side of this notice.
