- Q: How can I contribute to the Taxation Fund at the same time I pay my taxes?
- Check the amount you wish to contribute in the space A: provided and mail your check to the Collector's Office, Town of Tewksbury, 11 Town Hall Ave., Tewksbury, MA 01876. Please make separate check or money order payable to the Town of Tewksbury Taxation Fund. Please note that this contribution does not affect your outstanding tax balance.
- Q: Is there any recommended amount I should contribute?
- No, any amount will be gratefully accepted. The A: success of the Taxation Fund depends on the support of large numbers of individual contributors.
- Q: Who is eligible for fund assistance?
- All low-income elderly and disabled Tewksbury A: taxpayers are eligible. The Fund will be administered by a citizens committee made up of the Chairman of the Board of Assessors, the Town Treasurer and three residents appointed by the Selectmen.

- Q: Is my contribution tax deductible?
- Your contribution may be deducted from your A: Federal Income Taxes only.
- Q: Where can I get an application for tax relief under this Fund?
- Applications will be at the Assessor's Office and the A: Senior Center.
